The Piano (Pno.) has a rhythmic accompaniment. The Guitar (Guit.) part is mostly silent. The Drum Set (D. Set) has a simple rhythmic pattern. The second Guitar (Guit.) part has a melodic line. The Steel Drum (St.) part has a melodic line.
